Summary

All Men: There were 3,716 male players. There were 2,765 male players from the United States (74.4%) and 888 from Canada (23.9%). The leading sources of male players last year: Minnesota (524), Massachusetts (480) and Ontario (386).

All Women: There were 1,847 female players. There were 1,413 female players from the United States (76.5%) and 410 from Canada (22.2%). The leading sources of female players last year: Minnesota (370), Massachusetts (206) and Ontario (205).

All NCAA Players: There was a grand total of 5,563 NCAA ice hockey players in 2007-08. There were 4,178 players from the United States (75.1%) and 1,298 from Canada (23.3%). The leading sources of all hockey players last year: Minnesota (894 or 16.1% of all players), Massachusetts (686 or 12.3% of all players) and Ontario (591 or 10.6% of all players).
