

Girls Varsity Ice Hockey Head Coach 2024-2025

Northfield Mount Hermon seeks a dynamic and vibrant individual to lead the Girls Varsity Ice Hockey program at NMH. This position begins in the fall of 2024. While the competitive season runs from Nov. 1st through mid-March, responsibilities will start immediately assisting the admissions office in identifying and enrolling prospective student-athletes. This recruitment process could include some travel for the head coach.

The successful applicant will have at least a bachelor's degree (master's preferred), be proficient in ice hockey tactics and strategy, and have the ability to intentionally build a positive and inclusive team culture. The ideal candidate will bring a wealth of experience, which should include playing and/or coaching at the secondary or collegiate level.

The candidate will be responsible for leading all recruitment efforts of prospective student-athletes as well as supporting current students throughout the college process. Additional qualifications include strong listening skills, highly developed interpersonal skills, demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with colleagues, and experience in DEI work with a clear understanding of anti-bias education.

Candidates must be familiar with boarding school life and have an interest in making a positive impact on the lives of adolescents. They will demonstrate experience in equity and inclusion work that promotes a diverse community environment and a clear understanding of anti-bias education.

Responsibilities of the position include a combination of classroom teaching, student advising, resident dormitory supervision, or equivalent work.
