- work with other FS-IE staff on & off-ice team activities and training programs
- develop and implement weekly practice schedules and develop yearly practice plans
- analyse video and provide video review to all the players
- oversee on-ice practice sessions, develop team tactics and strategies, prepare players for games, manage the bench in game situations, and prepare written and verbal player evaluations
- transport players as required to and from school, games, etc.
- oversee the assistant coach and training staff
- assist, attend and participate in meetings and conferences
- monitor student-athlete's academic and personal progress through evaluation and progress reports
- An openness to understand the correlation between mentorship, implementation, and financial outcomes
- A receptive attitude toward a profession that demands multitasking and the ability to wear multiple-hats.
- Maintain communication on school academics with school liaison ensuring all athletes are eligible to play throughout the academic semesters
- Recruit and scout future players for the program
