

Graduate Assistant: Franklin Pierce University

The Graduate Assistant position is a two year position and includes tuition remission along with a stipend of \$8,000 annually. Housing is not included, but is available on-campus for \$500/month. Acceptance of the position is contingent upon successful admission into the University's Graduate School. Position set to begin 6/1/24 but can be flexible. First Grad Term begins 8/26/24.
