PSHI Development is an individualized video coaching program dedicated to helping hockey players become consistently hard to play against through detailed analysis and skill development. We are seeking video editors to support our player development initiatives by clipping player shifts from full game footage.

## Key Responsibilities:

- Receive full game footage of hockey matches via provided links or files.
- Trim and edit the footage to isolate and compile only the shifts for a specific assigned player, ensuring accurate start and end points for each shift.
- Maintain high-quality output, including clear video resolution, & proper timing.
- Deliver edited clips in a timely manner, typically within 24 hours of receiving footage. Games will be posted on Friday-Tuesday.

## Requirements:

- Simple knowledge in video editing software such as Adobe Premiere Pro, Final Cut Pro, iMovie, etc.
- Simple understanding of hockey gameplay, including the ability to identify player shifts, line changes, and on-ice actions.
- Attention to detail and ability to work independently with minimal supervision.
- Reliable internet access for downloading/uploading large video files.
- Previous experience in sports video editing or hockey analysis is preferred but not required.

This is a flexible, remote role ideal for hockey enthusiasts or freelance editors looking for supplemental income. Work volume will depend on game schedules and player needs, with potential for ongoing assignments.
