Men's Volleyball Club Coach - Operate, manage, and recruit for the inaugural season of the men's club volleyball team. Reporting to the Director of Recreation, the Head Men's Club Volleyball Coach will be responsible for all facets of the club men's volleyball program, including, but not limited to practice and game planning and implementation, scheduling, recruitment of potential student-athletes, coordination of team travel and many administrative duties. Must be flexible and available nights, weekends, and potential early mornings.

Qualifications: High school diploma is required. Previous coaching experience preferred.
