- Assisting with administrative responsibilities.
- Promoting the athletic program through community events, fundraising activities, alumni events and marketing.
- Adhering to all Association, Conference, and College rules and regulations.
- Performing related duties as assigned.
- The head coach supports the entire Athletic Department by performing an ancillary duty as assigned by the Director of Athletics.
