Responsibilities:

This position reports to the Head Hockey Coach

When assisting the Head Hockey Coach, any and/or all of the duties listed below are the responsibility of the position:

- Implement structure to the team's power play and penalty kill through on ice and video instruction
- Pre-scouting opponents power play and penalty kill to ensure the team is prepared for how teams will run both
- Plan and direct athletics skill development for athletes
- Recruit athletes compatible with the Tulsa Oilers mission and the specific goals of the hockey program
- Assist in advising athletes and staff of applicable USA Hockey, NA3HL, and Tulsa Oilers hockey specific rules, regulations, and policies and ensure compliance of such regulations
- Assist Head Coach in preparation and review of practice and game video
- Assist Head Coach in pre, mid, and post season player interviews
- Ensure safety measures are observed when conducting team activities
- Cooperate with the Athletic Trainers to ensure athletes receive proper medical and physical training services
- Attend all team practices and home and away contests
- Assist the Head Coach in resolving cases where an athlete violates an applicable regulation
- Attend hockey departmental staff meetings
