Position Summary

The Equipment Manager is responsible for the maintenance, organization, and transportation of all team equipment throughout the season. This role works closely with coaching staff, players, and team operations to ensure the team is fully prepared for every practice, home game, and road trip. This is a full-time position requiring flexibility around the team's game and travel schedule, including evenings, weekends, and holidays during the season.

Key Responsibilities

- Maintain, repair, and organize all player equipment, including skates, sticks, pads, and protective gear
- Sharpen skates and perform routine equipment adjustments before practices and games
- Manage inventory of equipment and supplies, coordinating orders and reordering as needed
- Pack, transport, and set up equipment for home games and away travel
- Launder and prepare uniforms and practice gear on a daily/game-day basis
- Set up and break down the locker room for practices, home games, and team events
- Coordinate with coaching staff on player-specific equipment needs and adjustments
- Maintain a clean, safe, and organized locker room and equipment storage area
- Assist with loading/unloading team equipment trucks or trailers for road trips

- Ensure compliance with league (NAHL) and USA Hockey equipment regulations and safety standards
- Track and manage equipment budget in coordination with team management

- Strong knowledge of hockey equipment, including fitting, repair, and skate sharpening
- Ability to lift and transport heavy equipment (50+ lbs) regularly

- Ability to work flexible hours, including nights, weekends, and travel during the season
- Valid driver's license; ability to travel with the team as needed
- Strong communication and teamwork skills
